

A firefly is a soft-bodied beetle. They are usually brown or black with light-coloured markings. They grow up to an inch in length. A firefly lights up due to a chemical reaction inside its body. Fireflies often begin to light up at dusk and end around midnight.

The larvae, that are newly hatched, are known as glow-worms because they give off a faint light. Glow-worms turn into fireflies after two weeks.

Larvae feed on snails and slugs while the fireflies eat pollen and drink nectar. Fireflies can be found in wet places with low vegetation. They are truly marvellous insects.
