Losing a loved one to cancer is a very sad thing. It is, however, heart-warming to see the tremendous response from the public. Thousands shave their heads, and still, more donate to this noble cause every year. 15

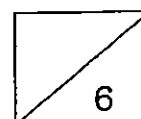

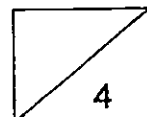
