

Giraffes are found in open grasslands in Africa. They feed on leaves on the trees and can go without water for weeks. Giraffes get most of the water they need from the plants they eat. They take turns to eat and drink so that at least one giraffe in the herd helps to look out for predators. They are careful not to be caught by the lions.

Female giraffes in the herd help to take care of their calves. Before a lion can attack a calf, its mother will position herself over the calf to protect it. She will use her powerful front legs with sharp hooves to put an end to the lion's life.
