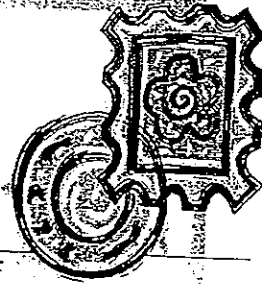
Dear David,

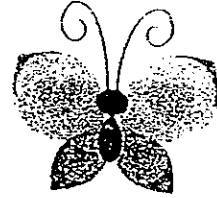

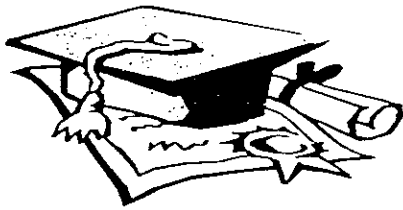
