The toys which are now stored in various places will be housed in a \$2 million place in Seah Street.</p>	5
<p>"It's every toy collector's dream to open a museum where he can share his passion with other people," said Mr Chang. The toys can be traced back to toy makers from more than twenty-five countries. They were bought from auctions, junk stores and dealers by Mr Chang.</p>	10
