



Bomeo is a treasure island of Asia. Not only is it the largest island in Asia, it is one of the few places in Southeast Asia where vast areas of forests still stand. These forests are believed to house the largest number of plant species in the world. It is estimated that there are 15,000 plant species in Borneo. This island is also home to hundreds of animal species that are found nowhere else in the world.

In the last ten years, 361 new plant and animal species have been discovered there. Scientists believe that this figure is only the tip of the iceberg as there are countless more unknown species waiting to be discovered.

Before scientists are able to unearth these unknown species, they would have been destroyed by the on-going human activities. People fell trees to clear lands to make way for buildings. Deforestation has also made poaching easier as poachers can enter the natural habitats of the animals to hunt for them.

A million years ago, orang utans could be found in many parts of Asia, ranging from Java, Laos to China. Today, it can only be found on the islands of Borneo and Sumatra. Threatened severely by habitat destruction and illegal animal trade, there are very few of these animals left in the wild.
