The Paralympic Games are an <u>elite multi</u>-sport event for athletes with physical, mental and sensorial disabilities. These athletes are just as competent as those who take part in the Olympics. However, athletes in the Paralympics are not treated the same as their fellow able athletes, who have always received credit for their <u>achievements</u> in the Olympics.

Tanni Grey Thompson is Britain's most successful wheelchair athlete. Tanni has represented Britain in the Parafympics since 1977. Her first big achievement came when she was aged fifteen and won the 100-metre race in the Junior National Games. Her massive trophy haul now includes eleven Parafympic gold medals and she is a six-time champion in the London 10 Marathon.

Born with spina bifida, she is paralysed from the waist down and is a wheelchair-user since she was seven. Tanni grew up in a sports family and her family background led her to be interested in sports. Since young, she tried sports like swimming, archery, basketball and tennis. One day, after watching the London Marathon on television, she told her mother that she was going to participate in the London Marathon some day. It was her dream to be there on the starting line with the other athletes. She had never tooked back since.

Tanni's achievements have not come about effortlessly. She worked 20 very hard by training 50 weeks a year, even through winter when the weather was cold and rainy. Her greatest motivation was that she desperately wanted to beat her husband, who is also an athlete. Her determination also helped her to overcome the obstacles she has had to face in her tife. Although Tanni has now decided to end her Paralympic career, she is not ready to retire. She will 25 continue to maintain a close relationship with sports by nurturing the next generation of British athletes for the Paralympic Games.
